

ORAL HEALTH SCHOOL SCREENING NOTIFICATION

Name of School: St. Mary School, Shannonville

Date of screening: Tuesday October 1, 2024

Dental Screenings are being conducted at your child's school for:

- Students in Grades JK, SK, and 2.
- Students in Grades 4 and 7 may also be screened.
- Any student as requested by the child/parent.

IMPORTANT:

- Parents who do not wish to have their child screened are required to advise the school, in writing, each school year before the scheduled screening date.
- Selected students with urgent treatment needs may be rescreened at this time or at a later date.

FYI:

- Oral health screening is a quick, visual oral assessment using a sterilized mouth mirror.
- The Oral Health Screening Team adheres to the Infection Prevention and Control guidelines set by Public Health Ontario while conducting oral health screenings in schools.
- The screening is a non-invasive oral assessment which can identify potential concerns.
- Oral health report cards are sent home with the children to inform parents of the results of the screening.
- The oral screening is conducted under the statutory authority of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.
- This screening should NOT replace your child's regular visit to the dentist.
